**ORDER GRANTING EXPEDITED HEARING
(Application for Authority to Sell Furniture and Equipment)**

Came on this day to be heard the Special Deputy Receiver's *Motion For Expedited Hearing (Application for Authority to Sell Furniture and Equipment)* filed by Jean Johnson, Special Deputy Receiver of AmCare Health Plans of Texas, Inc. and AmCare Management, Inc. The Special Deputy Receiver appeared by her attorneys of record. Although duly notified of the Motion, no one appeared on behalf of any other interested party.

Having considered the Motion and the representations and arguments of counsel, the Court finds that time is of the essence in selling the furniture and equipment to avoid penalties or increased costs to the receivership estates, and that the Special Deputy Receiver requires as much time as possible to obtain bids to sell the furniture and equipment. The Court further finds that it is in the best interest of the estate, claimants, and creditors that the Court waive the 14-day notice period and set the Application on the March 3, 2003 submission docket.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that the 14-day notice period is waived, and the Special Deputy Receiver's *Application for Authority to Sell Furniture and Equipment* is set on the March 3, submission docket.
