**ORDER AUTHORIZING DESTRUCTION OF NON-ESSENTIAL RECORDS**

On this day came on to be heard the *Application for Authority to Destroy Non-Essential Records* filed by Jean Johnson, Special Deputy Receiver under contract to the Permanent Receiver of AmCare Health Plans of Texas, Inc. and AmCare Management, Inc., (hereinafter "SDR" and "AmCare," respectively) for authority to destroy or authorize destruction of certain AmCare records. Having considered the Application, the Court is of the opinion and finds that the categories of records listed in Exhibit A to the Application are not essential and do not need to be maintained for the further administration of the AmCare estate and that it is in the best interest of the policyholders, creditors, and claimants of AmCare to approve the SDR's Application.

It is therefore ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that the SDR is authorized to destroy or authorize destruction of the categories of records listed in Exhibit A attached to this Application.

It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that the SDR is authorized to destroy other AmCare non-essential records without additional receivership court authority.

It is further ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that the SDR is authorized to execute any documents necessary to effectuate the purpose of the Application.
